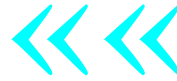
### Volunteer Hours

Printer in Plant Clinic—Gail Swan is getting a new printer head; hopefully this will fix the problems we've been having.

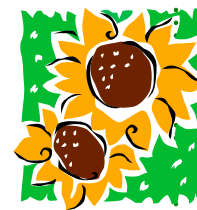
